Safeguarding at Chorley FC

Release Policy (Under 13-U18)

- Chorley FC is a community football club with the main mission:
 - To deliver a **footballing pathway** for local players to follow in order for them to play at the highest level possible
- In line with our main mission, we will always endeavor to offer any affiliated players a **pathway to other local teams** if they are not playing as much as they would like at Chorley FC
- There is **no official 'release'** from Chorley Football Club during the season whilst a player represents any team in the under age groups (unless there is a breach of the code of conduct)
- Where possible, all registered players are **invited to continue to train and represent the club** up until the end of the season
- At the end of the season, **all players are invited to join the first 3-5 weeks** of training with the next team in the next age bracket
- Within the first 3 weeks (up until the first game of the season) **players may be released** if the management team feel that the player would benefit from more regular football at another local club – this will be done through a 'face to face' conversation with the player (and parent)
- During the season, where a player is not regularly representing their team in official fixtures, the team manager will have an honest conversation with the player and parent/carer about the player's limited playing opportunities whilst representing the club
- Despite the potential limited opportunity the player is still invited to train with the team
- In line with our main mission, we will always endeavor to offer any affiliated players a **pathway to other local teams** if they would prefer to move on to another local club
- If a player is not showing a committed attitude to the squad and/or not displaying the correct code of conduct, then their position within the club will be reviewed

Release Policy (Dev' Squad)

- Chorley FC is a community football club with the main mission:
 - To deliver a **footballing pathway** for local players to follow in order for them to play at the highest level possible
- In line with our main mission, we will always endeavor to offer any affiliated players a **pathway to other local teams** if they are not playing as much as they would like at Chorley FC
- Players with limited playing opportunities are spoken to by the team manger
- If a player, through discussion with the manager wishes to seek more playing opportunities at another club, the manager, with the help of the secretary, will circulate the individual's details (in compliance with GDPR legislation) to other local teams

- Player personal details
- Consent to Photography & Video Analysis
- Consent to Medical attention, Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation
- Code of Conduct for the Player & the Family
