



Chorley Football Club: Spectators' Code of Conduct

To safeguard our staff and stewards and to help protect you and your fellow spectators, you are kindly requested to follow these guidelines:

- **Arrive in good** time to go through all necessary entry procedures. Ideally you should arrive at the turnstiles no less than 15 minutes before scheduled kick-off time. Make sure that you know in advance where your entry point is.
- Be aware that **your temperature** might be taken on arrival and you may be refused entry and referred for medical advice.
- Please wear a **face covering** when entering the ground and making your way to your seat or standing position.
- At all times, please observe **social distancing**, avoid close contact with others not in your social bubble and stay within your designated area of the ground.
- Do not attempt to access **restricted areas** or sit in seats marked as **not in use**.
- Please remain in your seat or standing location **at all times** wherever possible.
- If you do need to leave your position, wait for a time when **the gangway is clear** and follow any signs indicating which way you should go.
- If you are seated, please wear your **face covering when moving past other spectators** to get to and from your seat and try to avoid face to face contact with other spectators.
- If you are standing, please stay within your **social bubble** and remain aware of the movements of others at all times.
- If you need to access facilities such as toilets or food and drink outlets, please **wear your face covering** while making your way there and back and while queuing.
- Be aware that all payments inside the ground should **be contactless if possible**. Where cash payment is made, change may not be available.
- Maintain good hand hygiene: use the **sanitiser dispensers** provided and avoid touching your face, or handles, railings etc. whenever possible.
- Please observe respiratory etiquette – **always cover your mouth** if you need to cough or sneeze. Use a handkerchief or cough or sneeze into the crook of your elbow.
- **Avoid hugs, 'high-fives'** and any other close contact with people who are not within your social bubble. Take care when shouting, singing or celebrating and ensure you are not too close to or directly facing other people when doing so.
- **Obey instructions** and advice from ground stewards. If you have any concerns or require guidance or assistance, please speak to one of the stewards.
- When leaving the ground, please wear **your face covering** and leave by the nearest exit.
- If you are attending with other members of your social bubble, please ensure they have **read and understood these guidelines too**.

Please adhere to the acronym:



Frequent hand sanitation or hand washing with soap for 20 seconds.
